Rules and Information

1. Please email all entries to hiddenlakefarm@gmail.com
2. The entry fee is \$15 per class, **or \$20 per class after 10 pm Wed prior to the show.** To receive the regular class fee, get your entries in on time! There will be an EMT/office/ scholarship fee of \$30 for each horse/rider combination, and a non-member fee of \$30 for riders who are not members of DHJSC.
3. Warm-up classes are open to all. NOTE: It may be necessary to cancel one or more of the Warm-up classes if there are so many entries in the show that our ability to complete every division becomes threatened.
4. Riders must wear ASTM/SEI Helmets at all times while mounted. Proper show attire is required. As per DHJSC rules, no polo shirts or chaps are allowed. EXCEPTION: Polo shirts may be worn by jumper riders only.
5. Numbers must be worn on the back and clearly visible.
6. Proof of a negative Coggins report within one year is required by the State of Texas. This must be shown before numbers can be issued.
7. A horse/rider combination may only cross-enter into hunter divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference. This includes eq flat and under saddle classes.
8. All children must be accompanied **and** supervised by an adult.
9. **Dogs must be kept on a leash held in hand at all times.**
10. Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes, alter courses, and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries.
11. A \$25 fee will be charged for all returned checks.
12. There will be no concessions at this show.
13. **Jumper nominating fee:** A \$50 nominating fee must be paid for jumpers to compete for year-end scholarships. Fee follows the horse in change of ownership.
14. No one may call out jumps in jumper divisions while a rider is on course.
15. All trainers must be current DHJSC members.

In order to promote social distancing, the following steps will be taken:

1. Email entries, Coggins, and signed releases to HLF. Please note on the Coggins the name of the horse used on the show entry.
2. Courses will not be posted **but will be included in show packets.**
3. Only trainers (or riders without trainers) will be allowed at registration desk; will provide checks and receive packets containing courses, back numbers, and strings. Phone numbers of staff at desk will be provided in show packets. Trainers will notify desk of adds and scratches. Notify desk before rider enters the arena, and please limit calls to the desk.
4. Trainers will close out checks. Other than trainers, only individuals without trainers should approach the desk to close out checks.
5. Only one spectator per rider, and only one person per rider allowed in warm-up rings.
6. Masks are highly recommended for everyone at the show, especially when in close proximity to others. This includes sitting in groups at the barns or watching the show.
7. Riders will pick up ribbons from tables located in the vicinity of the gate, not from the announcers' tables.
8. Maintain six-foot social distancing.
