GUIDELINES

- It is the responsibility of the show management, exhibitors, trainers, and spectators to conduct themselves in a civilized and sportsmanlike manner.
- It is the responsibility of all trainers and exhibitors to be familiar with the DHJSC Rulebook.
- All children must be accompanied/supervised by an adult.
- A \$15 service fee may be applied to open checks not closed by the conclusion of the show.
- Excessive coaching by trainers, parents, guardians or other riders from the in-gate is not permitted.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

SCHOOLING: Sun. daybreak - 7:45 am

RESPONSIBILITY: Submission of entry to these shows constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Prospering Farm and DHJSC officials against any claim, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fee for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or its use of the premises or from any breach on the part of Exhibitors of any conditions of this Agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests, or invitees in or about the premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against Prospering Farm and DHJSC Management by reason of any such claim. Exhibitor, upon notice, covenants to defend such action or proceeding by council acceptable to owner. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property and Prospering Farm and DHJSC Management is not responsible for accidents, fire, or theft

ENTRIES: Each Class Fee- \$15. **There will be a post entry fee of \$5 per class if entered after Sept. 2!** Please note barn affiliation on entry form and check.

CROSS ENTRY A horse/rider combination may only cross-enter into hunter divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference. This includes equitation flat and under saddle classes.

FEES & REFUNDS: \$30.00 office and awards fee will be charged for every horse & rider combination. Once the show has started, proper notification of the scratch must be made in the show office BEFORE the start of the class or classes being scratched or else the class fee may be charged.

NONMEMBER FEE- If you are not a member then there is a nonmember fee of \$30.

RETURNED CHECKS: A \$25.00 fee will be charged for all returned checks.

DOGS: There will be NO DOGS on the property that are not attached by a leash to a person's hand!!!

ATTIRE: SEI APPROVED HELMETS MUST BE WORN BY ALL RIDERS WHILE MOUNTED. Riders must be properly attired – no chaps. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible.

RIBBONS, TROPHIES and CHAMPIONSHIP: All classes receive a prize and 6 ribbons. All Divisions will be awarded Champion and Reserve ribbons using the standard tally system: 10, 7, 5, 3, 2, 1. In the event of a tie, management will break the tie by over fences points. Champion rosette and trophy will be awarded and Reserve rosettes.

FOOTING: Warm Up areas and Competition arenas are sand. Ring 1 is 175 X 275, Ring 2 is 125X225
Hunter Ring 3 is 100 x200

CHANGES: Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes, alter courses and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries. Divisions with less than 3 entries may be canceled.

CONCESSIONS: Concessions *Sunday – 7:30 am to conclusion of Show*

STALLS AVAILABLE \$60.00 (includes shavings) per day/night (A NON-REFUNDABLE deposit check is required to reserve a stall. Call first for availability, then mail to 101 Equestrian Way Prosper, TX 75078)

COGGINS: Proof of a negative Coggins Report within one year must be shown/emailed ahead of time.

JUMPER NOMINATING FEE: A \$50 nominating fee must be paid for jumpers to ompete for year-end scholarships. Fee follows the horse in change of ownership.

COVID-19 Protocols

We take this virus very seriously and respect everyone's opinion.

RELEASE FORMS Each exhibitor will need to fill out the rider release form and COVID-19 release form. Your entry check must be attached to each signed entry form. The trainer will turn in the signed releases along with each customer's check together as a packet before the show numbers will be handed out **Parents will also have to sign a waiver before entering Prospering Farm.** These can be emailed in with your entries. At the end of the show, the trainer will need to close out the customers' checks

Only trainers or exhibitors without a trainer are allowed in the office.

Please social distance, by standing 6' apart at all times.

Each entry can only have 1 person besides their trainers at the show, so we can keep the number of people on the property to lower numbers to conform to The Town of Prosper's rulings.

Face coverings are strongly encouraged for everyone while they are at Prospering Farm within 6' of others. Riders while mounted are not required to wear a mask.

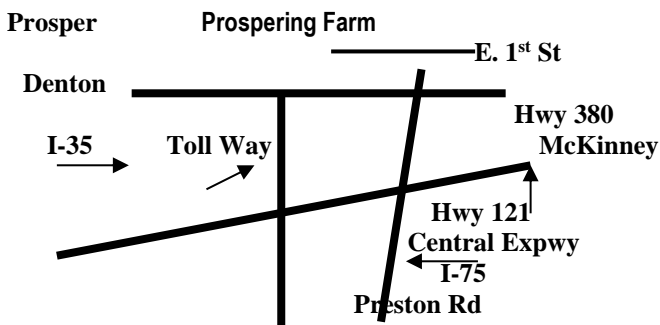
Please wash your hands often. We have 4 bathrooms. Bring hand sanitizers and wipes as you feel necessary.
