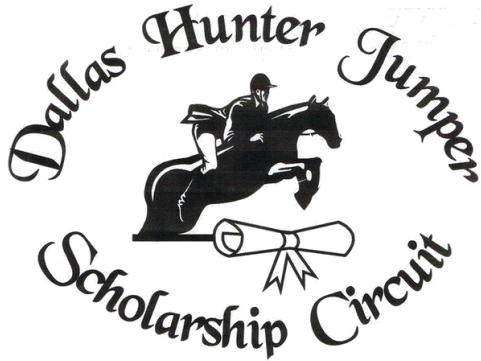

SCHOOLING: Schooling will be allowed on Saturday from 7:00 AM-8:15 AM, and after course change. Separate schooling break for short stirrup is posted. Schooling will be allowed on Sunday from 7:00 AM-8:00 AM. All other schooling breaks are posted.

ENTRIES: There will be a post entry fee of \$30 per horse/rider combination if entered after April 20! CLASS FEES ARE \$20. ENTRY BLANKS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNLESS SIGNED BY THE OWNER/AUTHORIZED AGENT, RIDER & TRAINER. NO NUMBERS WILL BE ISSUED WITHOUT AN OPEN CHECK. CURRENT COGGINS MUST BE PRESENTED TO THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE FOR ALL HORSES ON THE GROUNDS. Please note barn affiliation on entry form and check.

FEES & REFUNDS: \$30.00 office and awards fee will be charged for every horse & rider combination. Non-members will be charged a non-member fee of \$30 per show. Returned checks are subject to a \$50 fee.

DOGS: All dogs on the property must be held on a leash

FOOTING: Warm Up and competition arenas are sand footing.

ATTIRE: SEI APPROVED HELMETS MUST BE WORN BY ALL RIDERS WHILE MOUNTED. Riders must be properly attired – no chaps. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible.

RIBBONS, TROPHIES and CHAMPIONSHIP: All classes receive a prize and 6 ribbons. All Divisions will be awarded Champion and Reserve ribbons using the standard tally system: 10, 6, 4, 3, 2, ½. In the event of a tie, management will break the tie by over fences points. Champion rosette and trophy will be awarded and Reserve rosettes.

CHANGES: Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes, alter courses and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries. Divisions with less than 3 entries may be canceled or combined. **RESPONSIBILITY:** Submission of entry to these shows constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Hilltop Farm and DHJSC officials against any claim, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fee for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or its use of the premises or from any breach on the part of Exhibitors of any conditions of this Agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests, or invitees in or about the premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against Hilltop Farm and DHJSC Management by reason of any such claim. Exhibitor, upon notice, covenants to defend such action or proceeding by council acceptable to owner. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property and Hilltop Farm and DHJSC Management is not responsible for accidents, fire, or theft. It is the responsibility of exhibitors, trainers, and spectators to conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike and civil manner. It is the responsibility of all trainers and exhibitors to be familiar with the rulebook.

Division 1. Walk-Trot Rider Equitation over Poles- Open to riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons at poles or higher. Can only cross enter into Div 2. Classes 1, 2, 3 (Flat)

Division 2. Walk-Trot Rider Equitation over Cross Rails- Open to riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons at Xrails or higher. Can only cross enter into Div 1 or 3. Classes 4, 5, 6 (Flat)

Division 3. Short/Long Stirrup Equitation – Open to riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons. Fences 18” Crossrails. Can only cross enter into Div 2,4,5 or 6. Classes 7, 8, 9 (Flat)

Division 4. Full Course 18” Hunter- Open to Jr/Am riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons at 18” or higher. Classes 10, 11, 12 (U/S) **Full Course 18” Equitation:** O/F 101, Flat 102

Division 5. Open Hunter – 2’ Open to all horse/rider combinations. Fences 2’ NO Oxers Classes 13,14,15 (U/S)

Division 6. Maiden Hunter – 2’ Open to any Jr/Am rider who has not won 6 blue ribbon over fences at 2’ or higher. Fences 2’ NO Oxers! Classes 16, 17, 18 (U/S) **Maiden 2’ Equitation:** O/F 103, Flat 104

Division 7. Junior / Amateur Hunter – 2’3” Open to junior and amateur riders. Fences 2’3” Classes 19, 20, 21 (U/S)

Jr/Am 2’3” Equitation: O/F 105, Flat 106

Division 9. Baby Green Hunter- Open to horses/ponies in their first 2 yrs of showing at heights of 2’6” or higher. Classes 25, 26, 27 (U/S)

Division 10. Junior / Amateur Hunter – 2’6” Open to junior and amateur riders. Fences 2’6” Classes 28, 29, 30 (U/S)

Jr/Am 2’6” Equitation: O/F 107, Flat 108

Division 11. Modified Ch/Ad 2’6” – 2’9” Open to junior and amateur riders. Fences 2’6” – 2’9” Classes 31, 32, 33 (U/S)

Modified Ch/Ad Equitation: O/F 109, Flat 110
