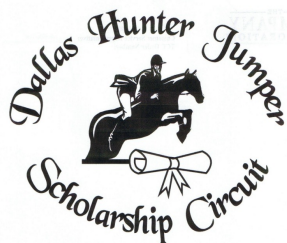

- Excessive coaching by trainers, parents, guardians or other riders from the in-gate is not permitted.

Entries: Classes are \$25 each Please note riders name, horses name, Horses OWNER barn affiliation and email entries to Jholmquest@gmail.com no later than April 3rd 6:00 pm

Fees and Refunds: there will be a \$30 office/EMT fee for each horse and rider combination. No scratches at the gate please go to the office for adds and scratches

Returned Checks: a \$50 returned check fee will apply to all returned checks

Stalls: Very limited, \$50 per day (no over night) or \$75 for the weekend

Dogs: We prefer you keep your dog at home but if you bring them they must be attached to a leash AT ALL TIMES.

Attire: SEI approved helmets must be worn at all times while mounted. Appropriate attire please, collared shirts, no chaps. Numbers must be clearly visible.

Ribbons and Prizes: All classes will receive 1-6th ribbons, All divisions will receive a Champion and reserve champion tallied by the point system

1st- 10, 2nd - 6, 3rd- 4, 4th -2, 5th- 1, 6th- .5

Footing: Ring 1: 110 X 220 sanded, Ring 2 100 X 200 sanded outdoor

Fences 2'3" 19, 20, 21

Open to riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons at Cross Rails or higher.
Fences less than 18" Cross Rails. 4, 5, 6,

Division 3. USHJA Outreach Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation–
Open to riders who have not won 6 blue ribbons at 18" or higher.
Fences 18" Cross Rails. 7, 8, 9,
