USHJA Outreach Competitions provide the opportunity to earn national recognition in classes from walk/trot to 3'0" in Hunter and Equitation sections and .60m-1.20m in Jumper sections at rated and local shows.

Any rider may compete in Outreach Hunter, Jumper, and Equitation classes, but riders wishing to earn points and national recognition must be a USHJA free Outreach member or any other USHJA member category.

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Rules & Regulations

Fees & Refunds: \$30 office/awards/EMT fee will be charged for every horse and rider combination. Once the show has started, proper notification of the scratch must be made in the show office BEFORE the start of the class or classes being scratched or else the class fee may be charged. Adds and scratches at the gate are not allowed; they must be done in the office first. Non-members will be charged a non-member fee of \$30/show. A \$15 service fee will be applied to open checks not closed by conclusion of the show. All classes are \$25 unless otherwise stated.

Stabling: \$115/stall, shavings \$12/bag (3 bag minimum, No Outside Shavings Allowed); \$45 grounds fee for any horse not taking a stall. Early move-ins/Late move-outs (arriving before 10am Friday, departing after 8pm Sunday) \$35/day.

Schooling: Schooling on Friday 10am to 7pm (NO EMT), Saturday & Sunday: See ring schedules.

Non-Showing Entries: Non-showing entries will be charged a non-showing entry fee of \$50 in addition to stabling or grounds fees (as applicable).

Responsibility: Submission of entry to these shows constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify & hold harmless Texas Rose Horse Park & DHJSC Officials against any claim, demands, costs & expenses, including reasonable attorney fees for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of exhibitor's business or its use of the premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against TRHP & DHJSC management because of any such claim. Exhibitor, upon notice, covenants to defend such action or proceedings by council acceptable to owner. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property & TRHP & DHJSC Management is not responsible for accidents, fire or theft. It is the responsibility of the show management, exhibitors, trainers & spectators to conduct themselves in a civilized & sportsmanlike manner. It is the responsibility of all trainers & exhibitors to be familiar with the DHJSC rulebook.

Entries: There will be a post entry fee of \$25 if entered after entry deadline. Early entries are greatly appreciated. Class fees are \$25 unless otherwise noted. NO NUMBERS WILL BE ISSUED WITHOUT AN OPEN CHECK. CURRENT COGGINS MUST BE PRESENTED TO THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE FOR ALL HORSES ON THE GROUNDS. A digital copy of the Coggins (PDF Preferred) may be attached with entries to speed check in. Please note barn affiliation, driver's license number and date of birth on all checks. Please note barn affiliation on entries. Please submit entries online at: https://www.horseshowsonline.com.

Returned Checks: A \$50 fee will be charged for all returned checks.

Dogs: There will be NO DOGS on the property that are not attached by a leash to a person's hand!!!

Attire: SEI APPROVED HELMETS MUST BE WORN BY ALL RIDERS WHILE MOUNTED. Riders must be properly attired – no chaps. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible.

Ribbons, Trophies and Championship: All classes receive a 1st place prize and 6 ribbons. All divisions will be awarded Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons using the standard tally system: 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, ½. In the event of a tie, management will break the tie by over fences points. Champion rosette and trophy will be awarded and Reserve Champion rosette.

Arenas: Texas Ring $-160' \times 300'$. Rose Ring $-160' \times 300'$. Hampton Ring $-135' \times 300'$. RWB Ring $-180' \times 300$. Warm-up areas and competition arenas are all weather sand composite. Rings may be closed during inclement weather or for maintenance at any time during the show.

Changes: Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes, alter courses and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries. Divisions with less than 3 entries may be canceled.

Concessions: Concessions will be open: Saturday 7am – conclusion of show, Sunday 7am – conclusion of show.

Special Classes

\$250 .90m-1.00m Jumper Classic

Class 204, entry fee \$35 members, \$50 non-members. Fence height: 2'11-3'3". Low Jumper Classic open only to riders competing in .9m or 1.00m-1.05m Jumpers. Order of go to be posted at 6 pm Saturday evening. Cutoff to enter or scratch is 6 pm Friday. Entries received after this point must go at the top of the order. Scratches received after this point will be charged for the class. To be held in Table II Sec 2b format. 8 entry minimum to run class.

\$100 .80m Jumper Classic (2'7")

Class 203, entry fee \$35 members, \$50 non-members. Fence height: 2'7". Open only to riders competing in .8m Jumpers. Order of go to be posted at 6pm Saturday evening. Cutoff to enter or scratch is 6pm Friday. Entries received after this point must go at the top of the order. Scratches received after this point will be charged for the class. To be held in Table II Sec 2b format. 6 entry minimum to run class.

\$100 .70m Jumper Classic (2'3")

Class 202, entry fee \$35 members, \$50 non-members. Fence height: 2'3". Open only to riders competing in .6m or .7m Jumpers. Order of go to be posted at 6pm Saturday evening. Cutoff to enter or scratch is 6pm Friday. Entries received after this point must go at the top of the order. Scratches received after this point will be charged for the class. To be held in Table II Sec 2b format. 6 entry minimum to run class.

\$250 Pony Hunter Derby

Class 201, entry fee \$35 members, \$50 non-members. Open only to junior riders and follows USHJA guidelines. Classic hunter course of at least 10 jumps including an in and out and a minimum of 3 option fences. 2nd round – Handy hunter course of top 12 ponies if available. 1 bonus point will be awarded for each option jump completed and in the 2nd round up to 10 points may be awarded for handiness. No schooling of the course is allowed. Ponies competing in this class may not cross enter into the \$500 Texas Rose Horse Park Hunter Derby. Late entries will ride at the top of the order. Larges to run during TRHP Hunter Derby, but judged with small and medium ponies only. Smalls will jump 2'0" with 2'3" options. Mediums will jump 2'3" with 2'6" options. 3 sets of ribbons 1st-12th place will be awarded.

\$500 Texas Rose Horse Park 2'6" Hunter Derby

Class 200, Entry fee \$50 members, \$100 non-members. Fence height 2'6" – 2'9" with 3'0" options. Open to all amateur, junior and professional riders. 1st round: classic hunter course of at least 10 jumps including and in and out and minimum of 3 option fences. 2nd round: Handy hunter course of the top 12 horses if available. 1 bonus point will be awarded for each option jump completed and in the 2nd round up to 10 points may be awarded for handiness. No schooling of the course is allowed. Late entries will ride at the top of the order. 30 minutes prior to the class entries may walk the course with horses in hand only. Ponies competing in this class may not cross enter into the \$250 Pony Hunter Derby. 3 sets of ribbons 1st – 12th will be awarded.

Jumper Medal

Two Jumper Medal classes will be held, to be divided between baby and puddle jumpers, and schooling through high jumpers. To be judged on the rider's equitation style, technical merit, judgement, and execution of an efficient track. The judge will issue a numerical score based on the rider's medal round. One point will be deducted for every second over time allowed (if posted) and four points will be deducted for each knockdown or refusal. At the year-end show the top six in each class will compete in a flat workoff. The points for placings from the year end show will double and be added to the current standings. In the case of a tie, the current standing points will have more weight than the year end points.

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TOP 10

INFORMATION MUST BE POSTED IN EVENT PRIZE LIST OR COMPETITOR INFORMATION.

- 1. PARKING: Parking in designated areas only. NO PARKING is allowed in the barn area. TEMPORARY PARKING in barn areas is for the unloading and loading of trailers only. All trailers should be dropped in the approved lot and are not allowed to park in the stabling area. Public Parking is in designated areas only.
- 2. CAMPER'S/RV'S/HORSE TRAILERS WITH LIVING SPACE: Must go to campground for hook-up. NO HOOK-UP ALLOWED TO THE BARNS AT ANY TIME! Limited spots available please reserve you space through the TRHP Show Services Office. RV spaces are assigned through TRHP Show Services Office.
- 3. GOLF CARTS/ATV'S: a privilege-not a right-extended to show participants. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicle, as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the Rental Agreement of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Golf carts can be rented through TRHP show services in the show office. Golf carts are rented on a first come first served bases and TRHP strongly suggests that reservations be made in advanced. NO FOUR-WHEELERS, THREE WHEELERS, OR MOTOR BIKES OVER 50 cc ARE ALLOWED ON PARK GROUNDS. Golf Carts, mopeds, rural rate vehicles such as Gators and Mules, scooters, small motor bikes, and bicycles are allowed.
- **4. DOGS:** Must be on a leash (not to exceed 6 feet in length) or suitably restrained in a tack stall/cage etc. Loose animal/s left in vehicles in distress, etc. can and will be removed from the grounds at the owner's expense.
- 5. HORSES: Have the right-of-way at all times.
- **6. EXHIBITOR PROBLEMS/SPECIAL REQUESTS:** All non-emergency problems or special requests must be relayed through show management to ensure prompt attention.
- 7. FIRE CODES: TRHP does not allow any of the following in stalls, barns or tents:
 - No 2-prong plug appliances. No 2-prong plug extension cords. No light duty cords for indoor use.
 - No 3-way adaptors unless specifically made for outdoors.
 - No cooking in barns or tents.
 - No smoking in barns or tents.
 - No overloading electrical outlets.
 - No electrical cords on the ground or buried. FANS IN THE STABLE AREA THAT ARE CONNECTED TO A 3-PRONG HEAVY DUTY OUTDOOR EXTENSION CORD OR 3-PRONG OUTDOOR ADAPTER ARE ACCEPTABLE.
- 8. STALLS: TRHP does not permit the use of any nails, fencing staples, screws, duct tape, or any other things to be driven into any portion of the stalls or buildings, nor the signs to be affixed, with any type of material(s) that may cause damage, changes, alterations, repairs, painting or staining of any part of the stalls or buildings. Any erection or installation of equipment must be made with material(s) that are temporary in nature and will not cause permanent damage such as zip-ties, Velcro, light duty staples, masking tape, etc. NO outside shavings permitted. Violators will be charged \$100 per stall.
- 9. WASTE DISPOSAL: All trash should be placed in proper containers that are located throughout the park. Muck generated during event must be placed in designated areas. Muck should not be placed in the barns, at the end of the barns, or in any other non-designated area.

- 1. All cart operators MUST have valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the sate in which they reside and proof of insurance.
- 2. This is an electric golf cart, which requires periodic charging. The charger is on the golf cart—do not remove from the premises. Charger should be kept dry. Be sure the cart has a good charge before leaving for an extended ride. ALWAYS unplug the charger before moving the golf cart. ALWAYS recharge when not in use, you cannot overcharge the golf cart batteries. When you sense that the cart is losing power (i.e. sluggish, slowing down), it needs charging. An overnight charge should last a couple of days of normal use. Make sure you have plugged both ends into the proper outlets and that the meter is registering that it is taking the charge. If the meter is not registering make sure the cords are plugged in correctly and fully.
- 3. Your cart has a toggle switch with F-orward, R-everse, center is Neutral, please keep switch in center position when not in use. When in the reverse, you should hear a backing horn (buzzing sound).
- 4. Maximum of five (5) persons, regardless of age, on golf cart at any one time.
- 5. Carts are NOT to leave TRHP property for any reason.
- 6. Please park the golf carts in a safe place at night do not leave out uncovered.
- 7. Golf Carts cannot be parked in fire lane.
- 8. Please take the key out when not in use. There will be a \$20.00 charge for missing key that is not returned to Rental Agent.
- 9. Remember you are responsible for any damages incurred to the cart or other property while renting the cart.
- 10. Please report any problems you have with your cart to TRHP Show Services Office immediately at 903-881-0348.

- 1. All RV guests must sign in at Texas Rose Horse Park Show Services Office. Check in time is 12:00 PM; Check out time is 10:00 PM on the last day of your visit. Unless a later time is cleared through the office.
- 2. RV's must be parked head in, to the left of the pedestal, as close to the pedestal as possible. Please use the hookups on the left, drivers side, of your RV.
- 3. When connecting to the water outlet, please leave back flow valves in place and insure there are no leaks.
- 4. DO NOT PARK IN STREETS OR FIRE LANES. DO NOT PARK BEFORE CHECKING IN AT THE SHOW SERVICES OFFICE.
- 5. Please observe the 5 MPH speed limit at all times. No ATV's, motorcycles etc. over 50 CC's are allowed on Park grounds. Anyone operating a Motorized Vehicle on TRHP Property MUST HAVE a Valid Driver's License.
- 6. Quiet time is 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM. Please remember that your neighbor may be trying to sleep. Rowdiness, loud music, abusive language, drunkenness, and possession or use of drugs is strictly prohibited.
- 7. All pets must be contained or restrained on a leash of no more than 6 feet at all times. Droppings and accidental waste material from pets must be picked up immediately and removed to trash dumpster. Pets may be left in your unit, but PLEASE remember this is Texas and it does get HOT.
- 8. Please keep the area around your unit neat and clean. Keep outside storage of items to a minimum. Trash receptacles are located around the Park for your convenience.
- 9. Open fires are not permitted. Fires must be contained. BBQ grills are allowed. Do not leave fires unattended.
- 10. Waste/sewage, water or effluent from sinks, portable toilets or other plumbing fixtures must be deposited in dumping facility only and may not be deposited directly on any pavement, dirt or vegetation. To set up an appointment with a mobile dump truck; arrangements may be made through the TRHP Show Services Office. This will be at your own expense. Check in the TRHP office for dump schedule.
- 11. Sites are designed for Living Quarters Units. No horse trailers may be parked in an RV slot, unless they are live-ins. Trailer parking is allowed in designated area only. All vehicles must fit within your designated site. Roadways must be kept clear of vehicles.
- 12. Parents are responsible for the whereabouts, safety and conduct of their children at all times.
- 13. All signs, posted notices and directions of the RV Park Management must be obeyed. Noncompliance may result in immediate loss of parking privileges.
- 14. Property outside of TRHP fences is private property. Please respect our neighbors' privacy. Please do not ride horses, or drive motorized vehicles in the adjoining neighborhoods.
- 15. All federal, state and local laws must be obeyed at all times.
- 16. TRHP reserves the right to refuse service or evict anyone in violation of RV Park Policies, or for destroying, or defacing property and/or creating a disturbance.
