#### KULES AND REGULATIONS

**ENTRIES:**There will be a post entry fee of \$30 per horse/rider entered after November 4th at 6:00 PMI Class fees are \$20 with the exception of ADDBACKS which are \$30. No numbers will be issued without an open check. Current coggins must be presented to the horse show office for all horses on the grounds.

Stall/bedding Count be emailed to Molly Hunt at <u>molly@huntersgatestables.com</u> HUNTER DERBY, .90m JUMPER CLASSIC, & .70m JUMPER CLASSIC are \$60 for members and \$110 for non-members

JUNIOR/AMATEUR HUNTER CLASSIC. are \$30 for members and \$60 for non-members. In order to be eligible for Derby or Classics, riders and horses must compete in a full regular division. Payout for Derby/Classics: 1<sup>st</sup>-28%, 2<sup>nd</sup>-20%, 3<sup>rd</sup>-16%, 4<sup>th</sup>-14%, 5<sup>th</sup>-12%, 6<sup>th</sup>-10%

FEES & REFUNDS: \$30.00 office and awards fee will be charged for every horse & rider combination. Once the show has started, proper notification of the scratch must be made in the show office BEFORE the start of the class or classes being scratched or else the class fee may be charged. Non-members will be charged a non-member fee of \$30 per show. A \$35 service fee may be applied to open checks not closed by the conclusion of the show.

**STABLING:** Stalls- \$100.00 – Shavings \$13.00 per bag (minimum of 3 bags) – Ground fees - \$45.00 for all non stabling horses. Stall reservations must be made in advance, late stall fees \$125.00. Early move in (before Friday morning) will be additional \$35 a day fee. Contact TRHP for coordination.

**SCHOOLING:** Schooling on Friday Ring 1 from 8:00am to 1:00pm Ring 2, 3, 4 open all day. Saturday and Sunday from 6:30am to 30 minutes prior to ring starting.

**FOOTING:** Warm Up areas and Competition arenas are all weather sand. **DOGS:** All dogs on the property must be held on a leash.

**<u>RETURNED CHECKS:</u>** A \$50.00 fee will be charged for all returned checks. <u>ATTIRE:</u> SEI APPROVED HELMETS MUST BE WORN BY ALL RIDERS WHILE **MOUNTED.** Riders must be properly attired – no chaps. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible.

**RIBBONS, TROPHIES and CHAMPIONSHIP:** All classes receive a prize and 6 ribbons. All Divisions will be awarded Champion and Reserve ribbons using the standard tally system: 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, .5. In the event of a tie, management will break the tie by over fences points. Champion rosette and trophy will be awarded and Reserve rosettes. **CHANGES:** Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes, alter courses and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries. Divisions with less than 3 entries may be canceled or combined. **CONCESSIONS:** Concessions Sat. and Sun 7:00 AM to conclusion of show. **RESPONSIBILITY:** Submission of entry to these shows constitutes an agreement to the full because the time to the the sector.
